# Designated medical provider

We are your workers' comp "designated medical provider." It is our responsibility to provide ongoing, up-to-date communications between you, your employer and your medical providers to ensure procedures and treatment plans are completed in a timely, effective manner. It is our job to play a neutral role in regards to your claim, and communicate with you, your employer and insurer regarding your injury and your ability to work.

## Need-to-know facts about workers' compensation

Here are a few items you should know about your workers' comp treatment:

- Workers' compensation insurance may not cover unauthorized visits or services without a referral. Our doctors can provide referrals to other providers when deemed medically necessary.
- We will coordinate your care until your injury reaches its "maximum medical improvement" (MMI) level. MMI means that your injury or condition has become stable and that no further treatment will improve the condition.
- At the end of every visit you will receive a "physician work status report." The report tells you about physical limitations you should consider on the job and at home. You will receive two copies of the report—one for you and one for your employer. The report helps you and your employer decide when it's best for you to return to work. For your own sake, it's beneficial to return to work as soon as medically possible. Until you are fully recovered, discuss workplace limitations or "modified duties" with your employer.
