CPT 82040	This test measures the amount of albumin in serum, plasma, or whole blood. It is often used to determine nutritional status, renal disease, and other chronic diseases, particularly those involving the kidneys or liver.	\$145
CPT 82150	Serum amylase (protein that helps digest food) is high when there is a problem with the pancreas. A common test when belly pain, tenderness, nausea, and vomiting are present.	\$230
CPT 82247	Bilirubin is made when hemoglobin is broken down by the body. Hemoglobin carries oxygen in the blood. Direct bilirubin is the measure of the amount of bilirubin that has been taken up by the liver. Indirect bilirubin is the amount not taken up by the liver. Total bilirubin level is the total of both direct and indirect levels.	\$126
CPT 82977	Blood test to measure the amount of an enzyme that may show liver disease in children or as a screening test for alcoholism.	\$141
CPT 84075	Blood test to measure the amount of alkaline phosphatase in the blood. ALP is an enzyme that shows liver cell damage. If measured from fluid from the sac that holds the baby during pregnancy, it is to screen for cystic fibrosis, a disease of the mucous and sweat glands.	\$55
