<b>CPT 82247</b>	Measure of the amount of bilirubin in the blood. Bilirubin is made when hemoglobin is broken down by the body. Hemoglobin carries oxygen in the blood.	\$333
<b>CPT 84155</b>	Blood test to measure nutritional status or how well-nourished someone is.	\$184
<b>CPT 82150</b>	Serum amylase (protein that helps digest food) is high when there is a problem with the pancreas. A common test when belly pain, tenderness, nausea, and vomiting are present.	\$539
<b>CPT 82040</b>	This test measures the amount of albumin in serum, plasma, or whole blood. Often used to decide nutritional status, renal disease, and other chronic diseases, mostly those involving the kidneys or liver.	\$184
<b>CPT 82977</b>	Blood test to measure the amount of an enzyme that may show liver disease in children or as a screening test for alcoholism.	\$273
<b>CPT 84075</b>	Blood test to measure the amount of alkaline phosphatase in the blood. ALP is an enzyme that shows liver cell damage or to check for cystic fibrosis in an unborn baby.	\$184
<b>CPT 84450</b>	Blood test to check the level of an enzyme that is found mainly in the heart and liver. Level is usually low unless there has been damage such as after a heart attack or liver disease.	\$184
<b>CPT 84460</b>	Blood test to measure an enzyme that is found mostly in the liver may mean liver disease if level is high.	\$184
<b>CPT 93005</b>	Electrocardiogram (EKG) Heart tracing.	\$238
<b>CPT 71045</b>	Chest X-Ray with 1 view from the front.	\$453
<b>CPT 81025</b>	Urine pregnancy test.	\$231
<b>CPT 87651</b>	A test for strep throat..	\$99
<b>CPT 84484</b>	Blood test to measure troponin level to check for heart muscle damage as with a heart attack	\$249
